REPORT

The SAIT Student Council Committee conducted the Class Representatives Elections on September 25th, 2024, for various streams. These included the B.Sc.B.Ed. I, III, and VII semester, D.El.Ed. 1st Year, B.B.A. 2nd and 3rd Year, B.Com 1st, 2nd & 3rd Year, and B.A. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Year students.

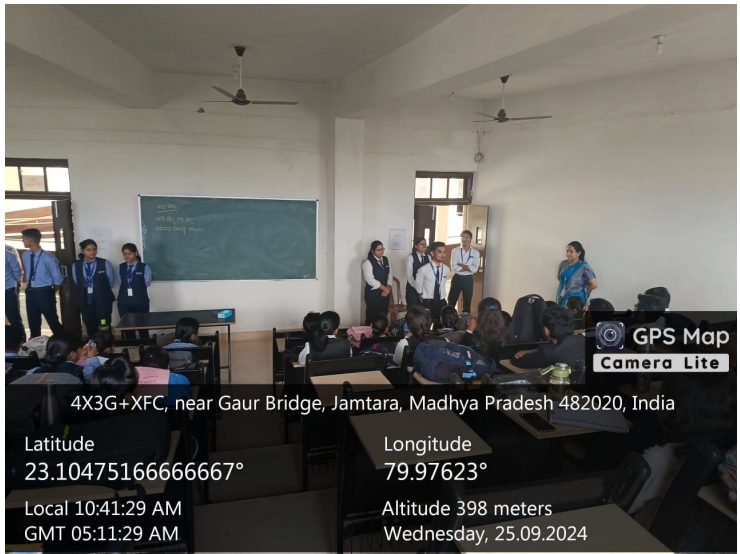
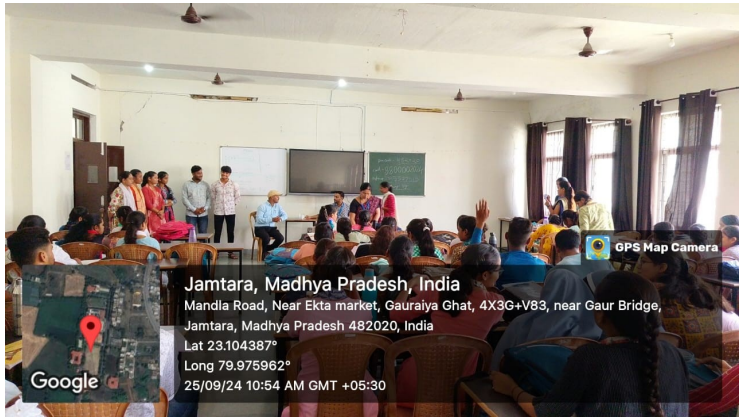
In the B.Sc.B.Ed. 1st Semester, 4 students nominated themselves for the role of class representative, and the election saw participation from 58 students who cast their votes in support of the nominees. Similarly, in the B.Sc.B.Ed. 3rd Semester, 6 nominees stood for election, with 60 students actively participating in the voting process. In the B.Sc.B.Ed. 7th Semester, 51 students voted for the 6 nominated candidates.

In the B.B.A. 1st Year, 9 students cast their votes for 2 nominees, while in the B.B.A. 2nd Year, 5 students voted for 2 nominees. The D.El.Ed. 1st Year elections saw 14 students participating, casting their votes for 4 nominees.

For the B.Com 1st Year, 6 students voted for 2 nominees, and in the B.A. 1st Year, 53 students voted for 6 nominees. In the B.A. 2nd Year, a total of 22 students voted for 4 nominees, while in the B.A. 3rd Year, 13 students voted for 4 nominees.

The elections demonstrated active student engagement across the various programs, with significant participation from students in selecting their representatives. This process plays a crucial role in cultivating student leadership and promoting effective communication between the student body and the administration.
